By entering FESTIV ARTY - Collie's Got Talent, you agree to accept and abide by the rules outlined below:



PERFORMING
ARTS

- In order to perform, the following applies:
 - Solo acts must live in the Shire of Collie
 - Duo or group acts MUST have at least one person living in the Shire of Collie performing in the act.
As well as performing, the person living in the Shire of Collie will also act as the contact person and spokesperson for the act.
- Each competitor may perform only once in this competition.
- The order of entrants will be drawn up after entries close.
- All acts, regardless of category or age, are in competition with one another. There are no separate categories.
- Entrants under the age of 13 must have adult supervision.
- If competitors are using sheet music for a performance, they must have original in their possession. (Judges do not require a photocopy.)
- The behaviour of competitors and audience is to be respectful, considerate and appropriate at all times. Organisers will act upon inappropriate behaviour if necessary.
- All backing music is to be provided by the entrant, preferably on a USB in MP3 format and clearly labeled. If you are using a CD, this too is to be clearly labeled. Entrants are advised to have a backup copy just in case.
- Instrumentalist entrants are to provide their own instrument; however, a piano will be provided if the need arises.
- Music stands will NOT be provided; this is up to the entrant to provide.
- Guitar amplifiers will NOT be provided; this is up to the entrant to provide.
- Microphones will be provided.
- Simple hand held props are permitted, but only if used in the performance. These are to be assembled and disassembled by the entrants themselves.
- **FIRE, SHARP INSTRUMENTS AND ANIMALS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
- Photos are not permitted, unless otherwise advised by the organisers.
- All competitors perform at their own risk. Organisers reserve the right to stop a performance if it is deemed unsafe.
- All competitors are responsible for the security of their own property and equipment.
- The Judges' decision is final and will not be contested.
- All winners will be moved through the Finals on **Sunday, 8 September, at 1pm.**
- If fewer than 15 entries are received there will be NO HEATS, all acts will go straight through to the finals to be held **Sunday, 8 September 2019, at 1pm.**
