Terms and Conditions of Entry

By entering the 2023 FESTIV ARTY Visual Arts Competition you agree to accept and comply with the rules and conditions outlined in this schedule.

To be eligible for entry the artist must qualify for 1 or more of the following:

- a) Live in the Shire of Collie
- b) Be a member of a Collie art or craft group or a student of the Collie Southwest Institute of TAFE
- c) Be an employee of Griffin Coal or Premier Coal
- d) Be a customer or employee of the Collie Community Bank branch of the Bendigo Bank.
- e) Non-residents of the Shire of Collie are eligible to enter Section A- Open Painting category only.
- 2. Each artist can submit a maximum of THREE entries per section. Except Section A Open Painting where a maximum of TWO entries per person will only be accepted.
- 3. Whilst all care will be taken with entries, no responsibility will be held for any loss or damage. Insurance and packaging are the responsibility of the artist.

4. Exhibits:

4.1 Canvas or Installations are to be no larger than 2m in height or width. Nor more than 30kg for sculptures. With exceptions for quilts. Installations must only need hanging by attendants.

4.2 Sections A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, Must be Framed or on a frame with D Rings on the back for installation at the Collie Art Gallery.

4.3 Any works that are not suitably presented or not following display requirements for the relevant category may be refused entry.

4.4 <u>All Exhibits</u> must be distinctly marked on the back with the name of the works and artist name and a phone number. A label is to accompany all entries, with your information filled in. Attached to the rear of the item with the right side exposed. See image on right. **4.5** All photographs must be matt mounted on black card. No frames or block mounts will be accepted. All photographs must be 5x7" in size or bigger (up to 11×8 ") and have Velcro on the back ready to hang (the spiky side). The name and address of the photographer must be clearly marked on the reverse. Exhibit label also attached.



4.6 Section A-F Must not be embellished with solid items. – lace, glitter, buttons etc.

4.7 *Woodcraft* entries must specify species of timber.

4.8 All turned woodwork items must be at least 60% turned. Any lamp exhibited must not have a lampshade.

4.9 All exhibits in quilting section must have hanging tabs attached and no visible name.

4.10 Exhibits Section A- U will be displayed at the Collie Art Gallery.

Section V-RR will be displayed at The Mine Workers Institute. Or at the Discretion of event organisers.

5. **Prizes:**

5.1 Judges for each category will be appointed by the Festival Committee, whose decision is final.
5.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any one category, prizes may/may not be awarded at the discretion of the judges in consultation with the event coordinators. All entrants authorise photographs taken during the festival to be reproduced for future advertising and events.
5.3 People's Choice award will be announced after closing of the venue.

- 6. If you have won a category for the three previous years consecutively, you will no longer be eligible to enter that category.
- 7. Items may be sold for a 30% commission. Please place full price on Entry form and label
- 8. Entries Close Friday August 25th 2023.
- 9. **DROP OFF:** Exhibits to be delivered to the Miner Workers Institute, on Throssell St on Sunday, 3rd September 2023, between Noon and 3pm OR The Collie Art Gallery Noon 3pm. Please contact the art coordinator at Hello@festivarty.com if other arrangements need to be made. Late entries will be exhibited for DISPLAY ONLY.
